City of Calgary Land Use Bylaw 1P2007 –Stakeholder Advisory Committee

January 18, 2008

The City of Calgary's new Land Use Bylaw will become effective on June 1, 2008. UDI – Calgary has been very involved in the development and review of the Bylaw and continues to provide input into areas of concern that become evident as applications are submitted under the new Bylaw.

The City of Calgary is putting together a stakeholder advisory committee to address issues that arise with the new Bylaw. UDI – Calgary will have representation on this committee from the Planning, Commercial and Urban Densification Committees.

The purpose of the committee includes:

1. Advice on prioritising new initiatives/research that have arisen from Administration, Council, industry, community and others.
2. Advice and awareness on general industry trends and community concerns;
3. Advice and input on proposed LUB amendments, initiatives and issues;
4. Bringing forward concerns and issues with the performance of Bylaw 1P2007; and
5. Reviewing and discussing results of LUB monitoring.

It is anticipated that the committee will commence meeting in April 2008. In the interim, if you identify any issues with regard to the new Bylaw, you may direct your concerns to UDI – Calgary and the applicable committee for review.
