Land Use Bylaw 1P2007 – Training Seminar Registration

March 27, 2008



LUB training seminar registration is now on-line.

On **May 7, 2008** the City will be hosting a one-day Land Use Bylaw training seminar at the Glenmore Inn. This training seminar is an opportunity for industry stakeholders to increase their knowledge, understanding and use of the Bylaw. Registration includes two training sessions (session 1 in the morning that is compulsory, and session 2 in the afternoon, that allows you to choose one of three options.) plus breakfast and lunch.

Registration cost:

- Early bird fee until April 15 is \$275 plus GST (\$288.75).
- Registration fee from April 16 - May 5 is \$300 plus GST (\$315).

How can you register?

1. Pick up a registration form at the Development & Building Approvals Customer Service Counter on the third floor of The City of Calgary Municipal Building (800 Macleod Trail SE).
